Each fellowship carries a stipend of \$15,000 plus a tuition and general fees scholarship.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Be eligible to receive a tuition scholarship from Ohio University
- Enroll in a full-time course of African language study
